## Participation Agreement

By participating in the Water Use Makeover Program, I agree to the following conditions:

- I will participate for a minimum of at least one year between 2017 and 2019
- I will complete two surveys about my water use: one before and one after the completion of the program
- I will provide Winter River-Tracadie Bay Watershed Association (WRTBWA) with copies of City of Charlottetown water bills for data analysis
  - If I do not provide this information, I will be billed for the remaining cost of materials that I received beyond what was covered by my participation fee.
    - *This project must report actual amounts of water saved because of changes made. If we do not receive water usage data from participants, then the project will not be seen as successful, and future funding may be withdrawn.*
- I will follow any water use restrictions implemented by the City of Charlottetown
- I will make my best efforts to conserve water indoors and outdoors
- I will not sell or redistribute the products supplied by the Water Use Makeover Program
- I am responsible for installation of water saving devices, such as toilets, or for the cost of hiring someone to install these items for me.
- I give permission to WRTBWA personnel to inspect that all water-saving products have been installed
- I recognize that water saving devices recommended by WRTBWA are products that should be suitable for most participants, but if I have concerns about specific features, I can choose to research and purchase these products myself and receive a rebate for a portion of the cost.
- I will participate in the Open Data project
  - I will pick a “team name” or be assigned a numerical code to help protect confidential data, but allow sharing of water reduction data
    - *As an open data project, data will be published in an open format, with the assurance that no private information will be disclosed (data will be designated by codes known only to project organizer, rather than by name, to assure anonymity)*
    - *The team name along with the quarterly water data will be on a public website to create a friendly water saving competition for a large prize awarded at the end of the program (2019)*
      - I wish to opt out of the Open Data project.
- I agree to have my contact information to be entered in the WRTBWA supporter list and receive email updates from the organization (approximately 10 per year).
  - The number of supporters that we have is an important indicator for funders. The more supporters we have, the more likely we are to get more grant money, and therefore the more good work we can do.
    - I wish to opt out of email updates from WRTBWA supporter list
- I agree to the general photograph release (details on reverse).
  - I wish to opt out of the photography release
- I agree to the suggested participation fee (details on reverse).
