


As water passes through the meter the "Sweep Hand" moves around the dial, each complete revolution of the dial equals 100 liters of water.



The triangular shaped "Low Flow Indicator" in the middle of the register dial will move when even the smallest amount of water is passing through the meter. You should use the" low flow indicator" periodically to check for leaks in your property.

How to check for leaks in your property using your water meters "Low Flow Indicator".

- 1) Check to ensure that all faucets, and any appliances that use water, are turned off and make sure that toilets are not flushed during the test.
- 2) Look at your meter and make sure that the "Low Flow Indicator" is NOT moving.

If it is NOT moving, you do not have any leaks.

If you can see it moving then there is likely a leak in your property, check your toilets first, incorrectly seated or worn out toilet flappers are the No.1 cause of leaks in the home.
