

# Snowshoe, trail walk set for Saturday

The City of Charlottetown and Winter River- Tracadie Bay Watershed Association are hosting a snowshoe adventure on Saturday, Feb. 16, at 10 a. m. as part of its Winter fun Weekend.

The snowshoe adventure will take place through the Winter River trails to learn more about the watershed.

This family- friendly event will take participants on an adventure to learn what a watershed is and discover where the city gets its water supply. Snowshoes will be provided by Outer Limit Sports on a first come, first- served basis. The hike will also include a break for chili, rolls, cookies, juice and hot chocolate.

The snowshoe group will be departing from the Winter River trailhead off of the East Suffolk Road at 10 a. m.

Here's how to get there: Take St. Peters Road out of Charlottetown for approximately nine kilometres. Turn left onto the Suffolk Road and drive three kilometres. Turn right onto the East Suffolk Road and drive 2.5 kilometres to the marked trailhead. A Winter fun sign will be posted at the end of the driveway. (Route 222 for Suffolk Road, 229 for East Suffolk Road). The total driving time from downtown Charlottetown is approximately 15 to 20 minutes.
