

Water restrictions in place

Charlottetown's Water and Sewer Utility department is reminding customers seasonal water use restrictions began Saturday and continue until Sept. 30.

Seasonal water restrictions allow watering only in the early morning and evening hours and prohibit hosing off driveways and other hard surfaces. The Winter River watershed is most vulnerable to water extraction during the summer and it is important for all residents to follow the mandatory water restrictions.

The city reminds customers to use water carefully, both for indoor and outdoor water uses, in order to preserve and protect water supplies.

If conditions remain dry and the water extraction rates are high, the utility will need to implement water shortage restrictions that prohibits all lawn watering and limits car washing to once per week.
